It is now available for flotilla use. In addition to keeping flotilla PE records in an easy to use database, added features include: printable class schedules, welcome letters, wallet cards, certificates, and more. AUXDATA: Printing Of Labels From The Member Roster Report:

When using the Member Roster Report to download labels for your unit, and you have trouble with the whole sheet not being in alignment, follow the following procedure: When in Adobe, check the printer settings. Click on Print Setup, click on Properties, and check Borderless printing. Click on the Custom Button to make sure the paper size is set to 8.5 x 11 inches. The whole sheet will then line up perfectly.
